We offer installment payments by cheque, telephone/Internet banking, and credit card. You can also pay by our monthly pre-authorized withdrawal plan from your chequing or savings account.

When you pay by installment, you have three options:

- 1 Pay your premium in full by the Effective Date -- (Full Pay Plan)
- 2 Pay your premium in two installments (50% by Effective Date and 50% in 90 days) -- (Two Pay Plan*)
- 3 Pay your premium in three installments (40% by Effective Date, 30% in 90 days, 30% in 180 days) -- (Three Pay Plan*)

* Applicable to 12-month policies only.

When you pay by installments, your insurance documents and your account statement are sent directly to you, so you receive them well before each due date. A self-addressed envelope is provided with each statement for your convenience.

A \$5.00 service charge is applied to each installment.

When you pay by cheque, insert your signed cheque for the amount due and your **Billing Stub** into the self-addressed envelope provided.

Contact your financial institution and select **WAWANESA INSURANCE** from their list of vendors. Your "account number" is your 7-digit policy number as shown on your Billing Stub. Enter the amount you want to pay based on the payment plan you have selected. When you are using telephone/Internet payments, each policy must be set up as a separate account with your financial institution.

Premium payments received by telephone or Internet do not constitute a waiver of our rights with respect to reinstatement.

Complete the Credit Card Authorization Form and enclose it with your **Billing Stub** in the self-addressed envelope provided. **You will receive a credit card authorization form with each billing notice.**
